

FILING A COMPLAINT

When a citizen files a complaint with animal control, they are required to submit the following information:

- Name of the person filing the complaint
- Address of the person filing the complaint
- Telephone number(s) of the person filing the complaint
- Address of the person that is committing the crime that is being reported

These requirements are mandatory for an Animal Control officer to respond. Animal Control officers need to have probable cause to investigate these crimes, which are sometimes occurring on a person's private property. In the event that you file a complaint, you may be subject to appear in a court of law to testify.
